CONSTRUCTION RECORD

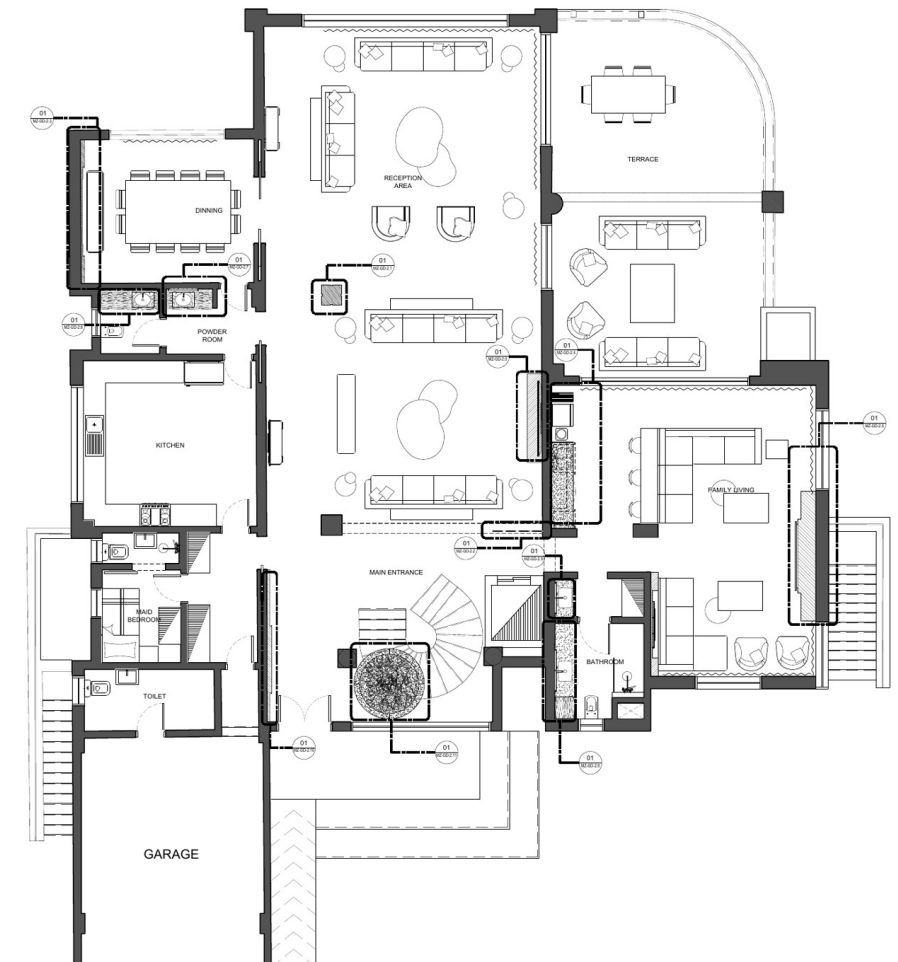
Close views show curved roof surfaces and exterior work in progress.

02 / MOVEMENT

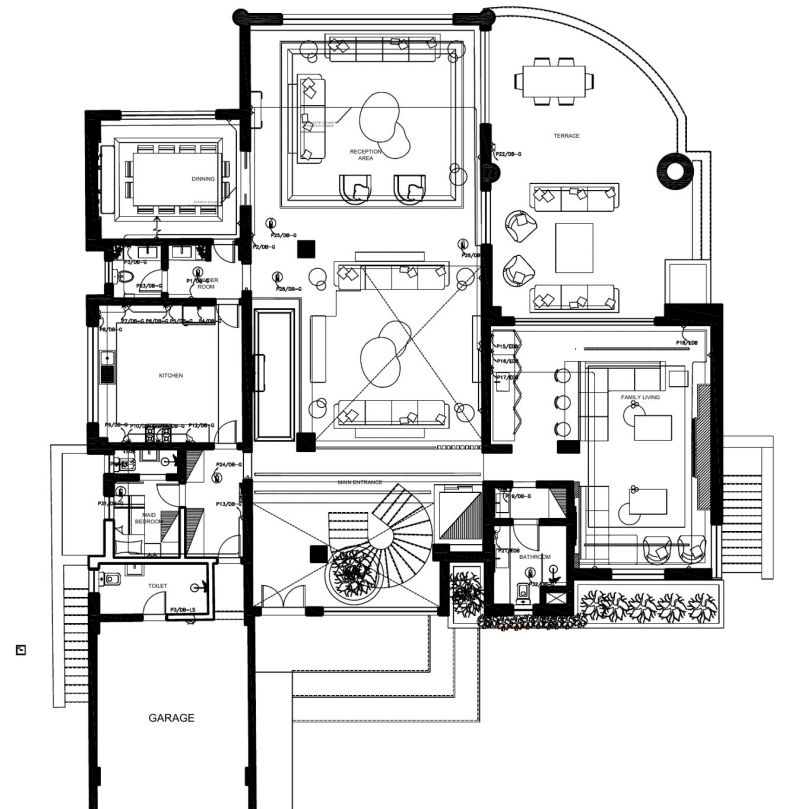
Read the clear routes between rooms and around furniture groups.

This arrangement is the reference for the service drawings that follow.

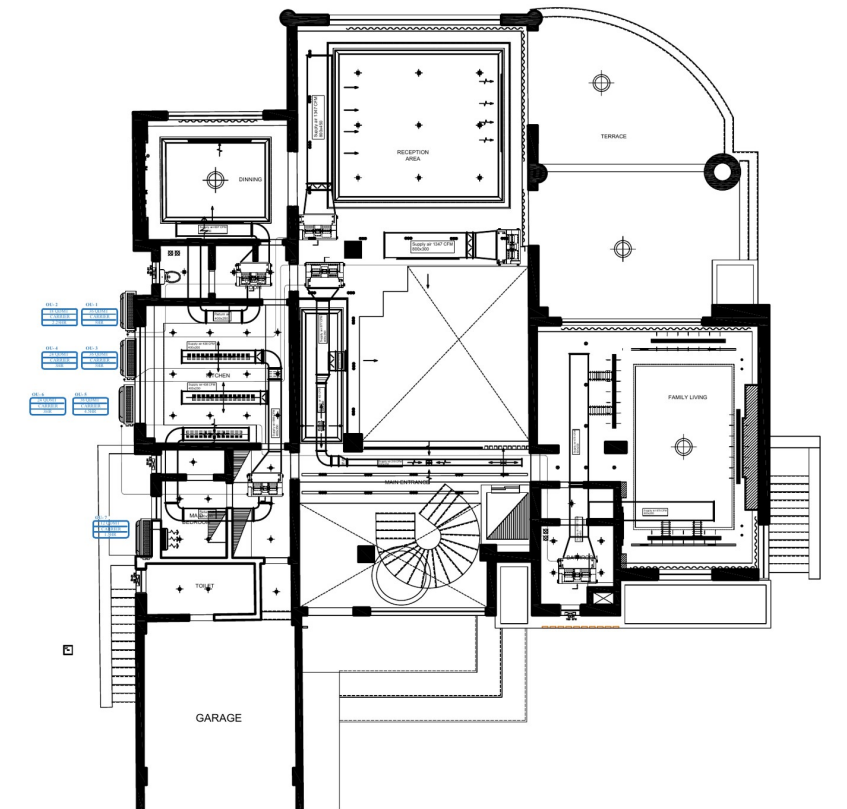
